

# Liability Waiver

1. Pet owner is responsible for their pet's veterinary care, if it is required while boarded at A Paw Above Canine Boarding Service, Inc ("boarding kennel"). The boarding kennel assumes no responsibility for veterinary costs incurred during the pet's stay.
2. All pets must be up to date on Distemper, Parvo, and Rabies vaccinations, in accordance with their veterinarian's requirements. The Bordetella (kennel cough) vaccine must be administered no more than six months and no less than 72 hours prior to boarding at the kennel. If the pet is coughing it will not be permitted to board at the boarding kennel. Veterinary treatment must be obtained and antibiotics need to be given for at least 5 days prior to boarding. Be aware; because of the many strains of kennel cough even vaccinated dogs can contract kennel cough. Current vaccination records must be provided to admit a pet to the boarding kennel.
3. Please have identification on your pet when they arrive for boarding. Nylon and leather collars will be kept on the pet while boarding, please no choke or pinch collars.
4. Please call if you are delayed and will be unable to pick up your pet on the agreed upon check out date. If you are delayed, additional boarding charges will apply, but your pet will not be turned out!
5. The boarding kennel is not responsible for lost or damaged toys, bedding or other items left with the pet. The boarding kennel provides elevated resting beds for each pet, please bring only blankets, towels or mats for extra comfort
